Doctors at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) seek volunteers, 21 - 65 years of age, to participate in a study researching if alcohol dependence and early life stress affect the ability to learn to feel calm.

All study-related tests and procedures are provided at no cost to you. Compensation may be provided.

Study involves:

- A physical exam, providing medical history, blood draws and answering questionnaires
- 2 MRIs with an overnight stay at the NIH Clinical Center in Bethesda, Maryland
- For heavy drinkers: An inpatient alcohol treatment program lasting 28 days at the NIH Clinical Center

**Eligibility:**

- Are 21 - 65 years of age
- Had a stressful childhood
- Are generally healthy

**You may not be eligible if you:**

- Have any major medical problems, e.g. heart or lung condition, uncontrolled high blood pressure, etc.
